- Encourage regular hand washing; we will do the same – and also have hand sanitiser readily available.
- Every classroom will have a supply of disinfectant wipes for surfaces, and commonly used equipment.

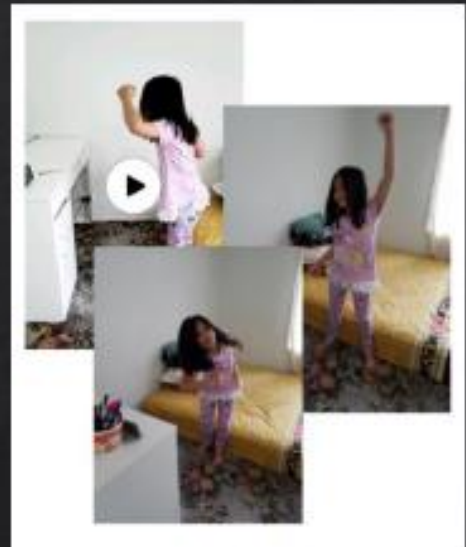

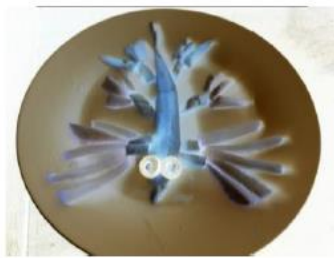

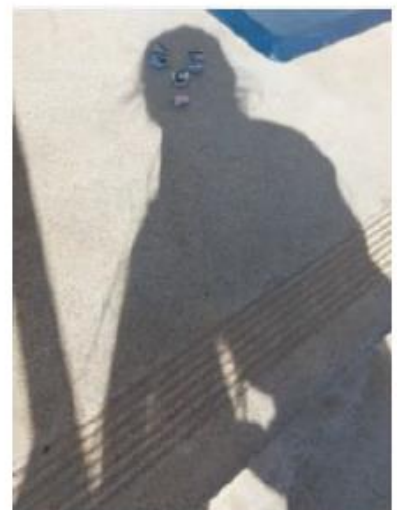
