














#### MY FAVOURITE FOOD IS ...

The best season for ice cream is Summer, Autumn and Spring but sum times I even have it on the weekend and even in Winter 🖨 .


I love ice cream so so much and if I eat it too fast I will get a brain freeze. A brain freeze is so cold!



Teachers and Families have been working together during this remote learning period and have discovered learning can continue at home in many different areas of the curriculum through Seesaw.


