## REMINDERS

UNIFORMS
Full school uniform should be worn every day. Our school uniforms can be purchased at the main office between 8:30am - 9:30am Monday to Friday.

## Timetable

Gates will be open at 8:45 every morning. Students can play in the grounds until the bell rings at 8:55; music will then be played for five minutes. This is the time when they move into their classrooms. The final bell will ring at $9: 00$ by which time students should be in their classrooms ready to start their learning. Students can access only two gates at the moment: the new one in Barton Street down near the playground equipment, and opposite that in O'Connor Street. When the Gym is finished, there will be a new gate in O'Connor Street adjacent to the gym building.

## All students are dismissed at $3: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ - when the bell goes. It is very important that your child knows which gate to meet you at.

Students should not have mobile phones/smart watches at school. If there is a specific reason why you feel your child needs to bring a phone/smart watch, you need to speak to Connie Williams or myself. If we agree that the phones can come to school, they must be brought to the office in the mornings. WE will keep them safe during the day and they can be collected at 3:30 before the students goes home.

The Camp for Years 3 and 4 takes place during the second week of next term; $2^{\text {nd }}$ to $4^{\text {th }}$ May. Students will be enjoying Lake Dewar. This "away from home" experience is extremely valuable but also really enjoyable as the activities provided are terrific fun.
