The very first was last Thursday. You can see by the smiles just how much the new “Prep 2023” children are enjoying their time with our current Prep “handy helpers”.



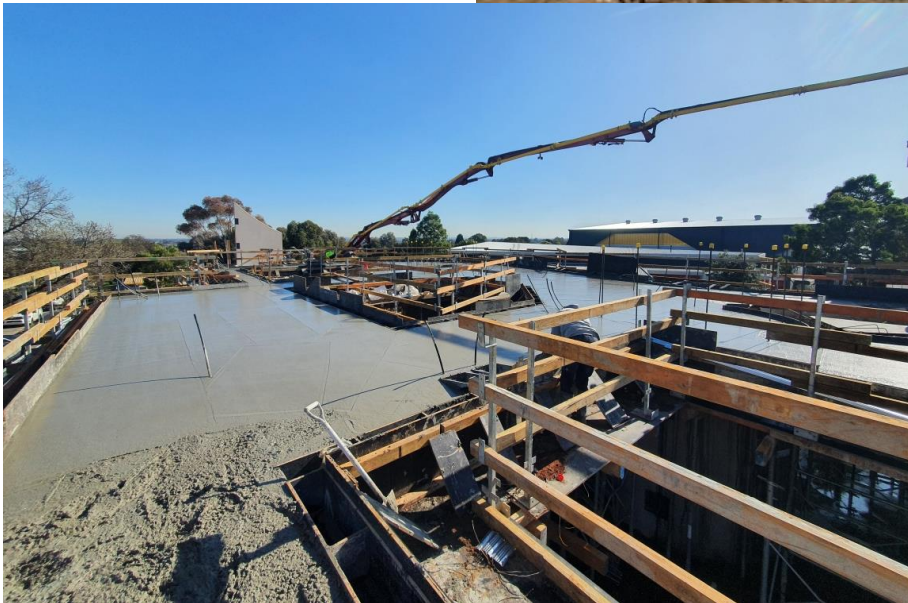

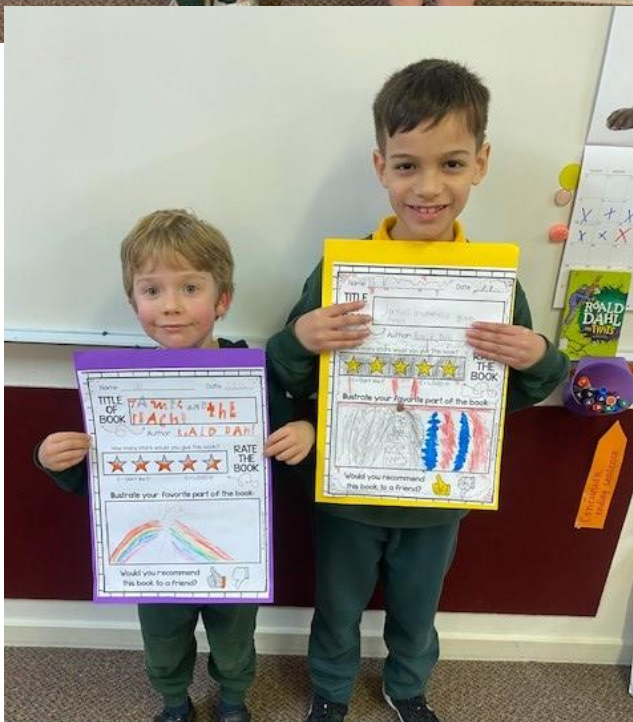
During last term we read a book called 'James and the Giant Peach', written by the author Roald Dahl.

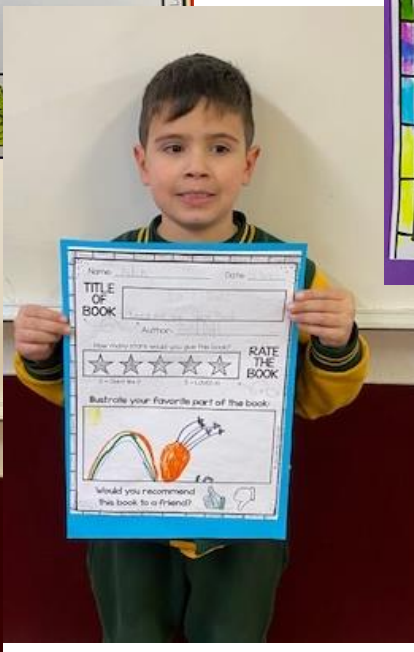

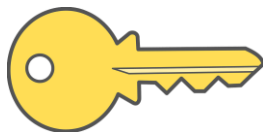
