I look forward to a very rewarding and successful year for our parents, staff and most importantly our students.

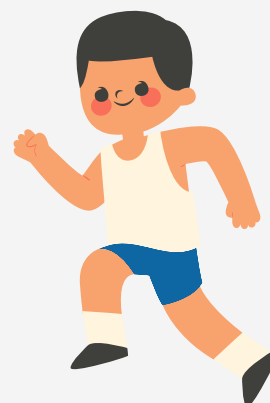

Early Pick Ups

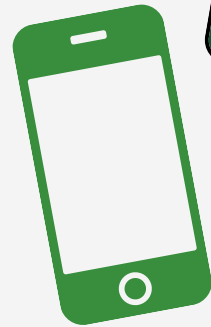

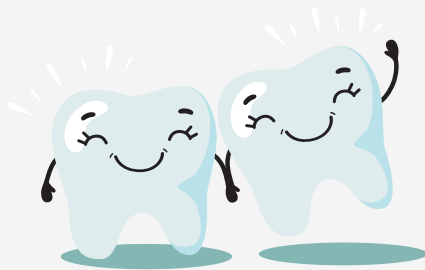
Please note the following:

SMILE SQUAD



Dear Parents/Carers,

The smile squad will be coming to our school on **Monday 27th of February**.

What is Smile Squad?

This initiative is led by the Department of Health and Dental Health Services Victoria with input and support from the Department of Education and Training. It provides free dental care to all Victorian primary and secondary government school students.

How does it work?

If you would like your child to be seen by Smile Squad, please complete the consent form. You can do this by following the QR code below which will link you to an electronic consent form or following this link <https://dentalhealthservicesvictoria.snapforms.com.au/form/sdp-consent-form>



Once completed your child will be added to the list. Your child will also bring home a free dental pack which includes a toothbrush, toothpaste and some oral health information.

Consent forms will need to be completed as soon as possible to ensure your child is added to the list.

The Smile Squad will be at our school to begin examinations on **Monday 27th of February**. All follow up treatment will take place in a dental van at school once parents/carers have been notified of the treatment required.

This is a great opportunity for your child to receive some free dental care.
