## Schools in the Past

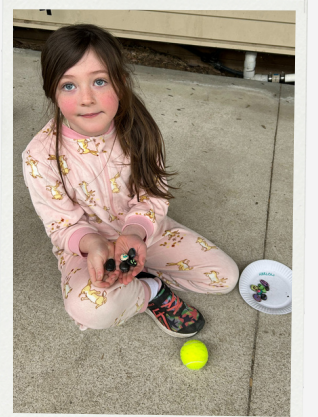

*It has been so interesting learning about how schools in the past are different to schools now.*

# INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC

## MINI COMPOSERS IN PIANO CLASS

A look into the song writing process of our budding composers!

During Term 3, senior school piano students at Reservoir Primary School have been learning about musical composition by creating their very own songs!

Students have taken to the task with great enthusiasm, first working as a group to create a **chord progression** to be played in the left hand part of their compositions.

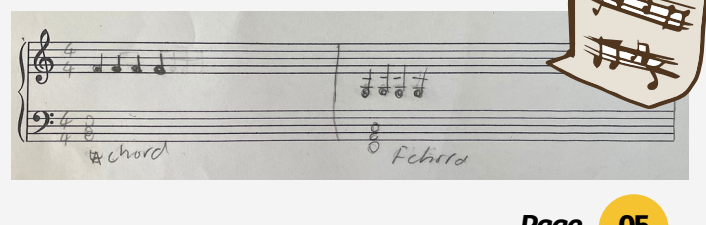
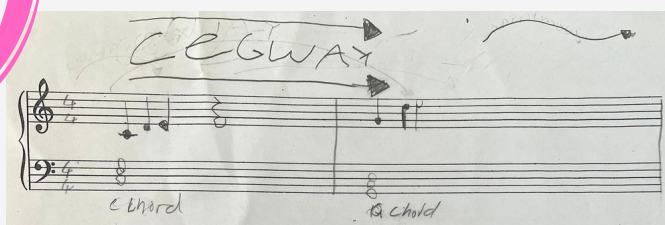
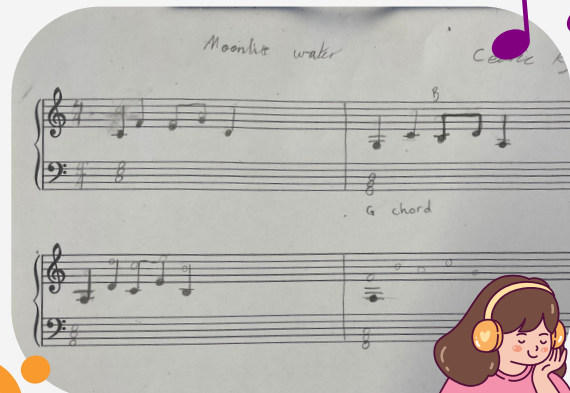
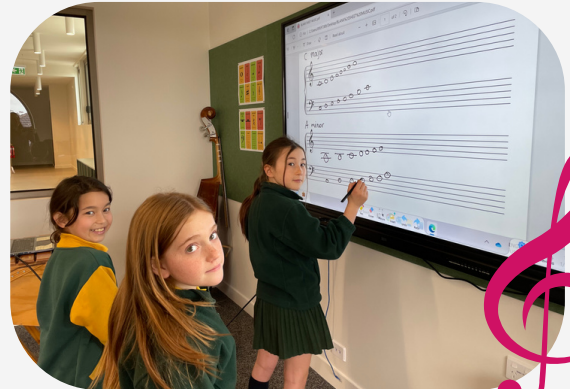
For the right hand part of their compositions, students embraced creative license, experimenting with various combinations of notes from the **C Major Scale** and often utilising repeating patterns, to create their own unique **rhythm** and **melody**.

After coming up with their chosen melody, students have been focussing on their notation skills by drawing the notes on blank sheet music by hand.

Students will further develop their music composition skills by adding markings to indicate specific **dynamics** (volume), **articulation** (touch), **tempo** (speed) and a **title**, to create their chosen mood and encourage musical expression.

We can't wait to share and perform the final versions of student compositions later this term!

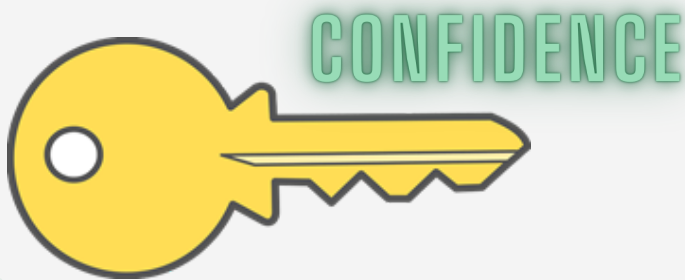
