Back at school we have been learning about water safety - **Archie**


We made a PowerPoint about beach safety or pool safety. We also made a frog with paper. It was pretty hard - Donna

When the others went swimming, we made a PowerPoint on water safety, we made a poster and origami frogs - Rose


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


